

Election Required - Unique Trade Identifiers ("UTIs")

In connection with the reporting requirements under Article 9 of Regulation (EU) No 648/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 4 July 2012 on OTC derivatives, central counterparties and trade repositories ("**EMIR**"), counterparties are required to generate and agree UTIs in respect of the derivative contracts to be reported.

We are seeking your election as to the process for generating UTIs where trades are not executed on a middleware platform, an e-platform or other means where UTI generation is agreed at the outset.

In such cases, UTIs may be generated (a) by HSBC, which subsequently notifies you of such UTI, (b) by you, and you subsequently notify HSBC of such UTI within one business day of its generation, or (c) in accordance with ISDA Logic, which is a set of best practice tie-breaker rules used to determine the generating party and may result in you or HSBC generating a UTI for a given trade.
